Kindergarten:

3 bottles of Elmer's Glue Elmer's School Glue or All Purpose Glue. Please do not buy the "No Run," glitter, or colored glue. Please do not put your child's name or initials on the glue.	3 black and white composition books
2 folders with pockets and prongs Please send solid color folders, do not buy character or specialty folders.	1 package of pink block-style erasers Please do not send pencil top erasers.
1 box of water-based colored markers	1 bottle of hand sanitizer
2 bottles of liquid hand soap Regular or refill varieties are both acceptable.	1 book bag A book bag with a large opening and only 1 or 2 compartments is best. Please, <u>no wheels</u> . Label with your child's first and last name.
1 bath towel A solid colored bath towel will be needed for quiet time. Please place the towel in a 2.5 gallon Hefty zipper bag with your child's name on it. 1st Grade:

Loose leaf paper, <u>wide ruled</u> about 3-4 packs	Science Supplies:

5th Grade:

1 recorder -Only for students NOT enrolled in Band (Students may use the recorder from 4 th grade. New ones can be purchased at a local music store.)	3-4 black Sharpie markers, ultra fine point
