Student actors in Charles County's six public high schools are preparing for fall plays, which begin next month. The following is a list of school plays, ticket and contact information for each high school:

First in the fall play season are productions at La Plata, Maurice J. McDonough and North Point high schools.

La Plata will present "Reckless," a comedy by Craig Lucas. Performance dates are Nov. 12-14. Performance time for all three dates is 6:30 p.m. Tickets are \$10 for adults, \$5 for students and \$4 for thespians. Call 301-934-1100 for more information.

McDonough will present William McNulty's "Dracula," Nov. 5-7, at 7 p.m., and Nov. 8 at 2 p.m. Tickets are \$10 for adults, \$8 for students and \$7 for student thespians. McDonough students will also be hosting "Dracula's Lair," a haunted cemetery in the back of the auditorium, to raise money for Trick or Treat So Kids Can Eat. North Point High School is presenting its fall production, "The Man Who Came to Dinner" on Nov. 12-14. Performance time for all three dates is 7 p.m. Tickets are \$8 for adults, and \$5 for students and senior citizens.

Lackey will present William Shakespeare's "Much Ado About Nothing" on Nov. 20-21, 7:30 p.m., and Nov. 22 at 2 p.m. Ticket prices are \$8 for adults, \$7 for students and senior citizens, and \$6 for thespians.
