So what is available in theatre for incoming Freshman:

Courses:

Theatre I— This course is designed first, to increase your level of self-awareness and confidence; the capacity to take and actor's poise, command and concentration into your own life, even if you never go near a theatre again. Second, you will discover the history of theatre as well as how all the design elements of a production unite for a performance. Lastly you will survey different genres of plays and will have the opportunity to create your own scripts.
